Ashdale Secondary College identifies, acknowledges and fosters its students' strengths. To embrace this philosophy, the College offers a Soccer Academy to male and female students which fosters students' passion, commitment and skill in Physical Education.

Students in the Academy have the desire and commitment to improve their skills, game play and fitness in order to excel within the sporting arena. They represent Ashdale Secondary College with pride and are positive ambassadors for the Academy and for the College.

Our aim is to provide an avenue for your child to achieve excellence in their chosen sporting domain. Students within the Academy will focus on Soccer for two sessions of Physical Education each week. Students have the opportunity to build on their passion for the sport through the

development of skills, fitness, strategies, tactics and officiating. Throughout the duration of the program students will have exposure to coaching experts and guest speakers, opportunities to attain coaching and umpiring qualifications and work with younger athletes from the Cluster primary schools. Students interested may be required to complete a trial process to become part of the program.

The ASC Soccer Academy focus is not only on physical skills but the development of social and interpersonal skills and the sense of belonging to a team and the Ashdale Community. In Year 7 students participate in Beach Games that focus on team-building. As students progress into Year 9 they are given the opportunity to represent ASC as spectators at State and National games.

Students in the Academy should aim to meet the following criteria at all times:

- Be a leader in the school and a positive role model to peers.
- Demonstrate outstanding attendance, behaviour and performance in all faculties across the College.
- Display a high level of organisation, punctuality and independence.
- Represent the College in SSWA Carnivals and Indoor Competitions. This will maintain your position in the Academy.
- Wear appropriate uniform for Academy lessons, ie. PE sports uniform and soccer shoes.
- Are recommended to play soccer outside of school for a club.

In Year 10, students involved with the Academy will complete Sports Science Soccer creating the foundations of a career pathway in the sport and recreation industry. The completion of this course provides students with points towards their Western Australian Certificate of Education. Students may also have the prospect of interstate tours to play at a national level.

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Soccer Trial - Friday 6 August (Term 3)

Interested primary school students will need to be at Ashdale Secondary College at 8.30 am on Friday 6 August 2021.

The trial will take approximately two (2) hours after which they are to be collected and returned to their primary school. Any students who are injured or unable to attend on the trial date will be viewed during Transition in Term 4.

Acceptance letters will be issued in Term 4.
