- Most recent school report
- Most recent NAPLAN report
- Diagnostic reports confirming Autism diagnosis – confirmation from paediatrician after triage with Speech Pathologist and Clinical Psychologist
- Signed Permission to Release and/or Exchange Information form.

**Transition:**

- Transition of your child, if successful will be conducted during Term 4 2021
- Dates and procedures of this process will be advised.
