

Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to my previous COVID-19 communications, you may have seen the announcement of the high caseload settings in place across WA as of Tuesday, 8 February 2022. This includes additional measures to keep our schools open and provide face-to-face learning to your children.

Parents and carers can no longer enter classrooms in the current settings, including volunteering.

Parents are permitted on College grounds for drop-off and pick-up in outdoor locations, but please distance physically, avoid gathering where possible and follow mask-wearing requirements as applicable in our region.

We are currently planning and implementing additional ways to minimise the risk of COVID-19 entering or being transmitted at Ashdale Secondary College, including:

- moving parent-teacher interviews to online or over the phone;
- changing indoor face-to-face events;
- cancelling or postponing school camps;
- limiting the mingling of groups;
