ICT APPROVED SPECIALIST PROGRAM

The Department of Education WA Information & Communication Technology (ICT) Approved Specialist Program at Ashdale Secondary College gives students access to the latest technology, methods, content delivery and opportunities to explore this exciting, fast-paced industry.

The Ashdale ICT Approved Specialist Program offers students the choice of two Institutes to develop their knowledge and skills further; Creative Technologies or STEM. Both Institutes provide a clear pathway to Senior School studies offering a broad and diverse range of courses available across ATAR and VET.

Our expert teachers undertake staff development programs that encourage inquiry-based teaching and learning strategies. There is a strong emphasis on creative and critical thinking, scientific method, and stimulating young minds' natural curiosity and innovation.

The facilities and equipment at Ashdale Secondary College are world-class. Students have access to the latest technology throughout the College, including:

- a vibrant Creative Lab including the use of 3D printers
- robotics & mechatronics workshop
- e-textiles & maker space workshop
- iMac labs, TV studio, surface tablets and the latest software.



The Program requires a three-year commitment (Years 7 to 9) to fully develop the students as self-directed learners with exceptional higher-order thinking. All students enrolled in the program who successfully complete their course requirements over three years will have the opportunity to pursue further studies on an ATAR pathway as part of their WACE achievements.

CREATIVE TECHNOLOGIES INSTITUTE

The Creative Technologies Institute delivers an enriched digital technologies curriculum while developing students' skills in various areas of ICT. These areas include graphic design, photo media, coding, lego robotics, circuitry, entrepreneurial skills, project management, video game design and the latest innovations in the technology industry.

Classes are designed to provide students with a unique learning experience focused on fostering creativity and innovation.

Students also have access to specialised excursions, incursions, guest speakers, industry partnerships and expos.

The College's research-based learning models are used to develop the ICT capability of students, as they learn to use ICT effectively and appropriately to access, create, communicate information and ideas, solve problems and work collaboratively.



STEM INSTITUTE

The STEM Institute delivers an enriched and accelerated curriculum across Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics, nurturing high achieving students to target career paths across many leading-edge STEM professions.

Curriculum delivery within the STEM Institute focuses on an interdisciplinary approach across the STEM subjects. Lessons are designed around finding solutions to real-world problems. The STEM Institute teaches critical thinking and problem-solving skills and creates an environment that promotes innovation, collaboration, and an entrepreneurial mindset.

Students in the STEM Institute will have access to tertiary and industry partners, exposing them to professionals within the STEM fields. They will have the opportunity to showcase their work in various forums, including expos, competitions and business projects. Incursions and excursions are a valuable part of the program, enriching and enhancing the learning experience.

NETBALL AND SOCCER ACADEMIES

Ashdale Secondary College identifies, acknowledges and fosters its students' strengths. To embrace this philosophy, the College offers a Netball and Soccer Academy that encourages students' passion, commitment and skill in Physical Education.

Students in each Academy have the desire and commitment to improving their skills, game-play and fitness to excel within the sporting arena. They represent Ashdale Secondary College with pride and are positive ambassadors for their Academy and the College.

Students within the Academy will focus on their chosen sport for two sessions of Physical Education each week. They will have the opportunity to build on their passion for the sport by developing skills, fitness, strategies, tactics and officiating. Students have exposure to coaching experts and guest speakers throughout the program and opportunities to attain coaching and umpiring qualifications and work with younger athletes from the Cluster Primary Schools.

The focus of each Academy is not only on physical skills but the development of social and interpersonal skills, the sense of belonging to a team and the Ashdale Community.

Students are provided with a range of opportunities in each Academy, including team building days, College representation at national sporting events and international tours.

If students progress into Senior School, they will be involved in the Specialised Sport Science program in Year 10, creating a career pathway in the Sport and Recreation Industry. Year 11 students will complete the nationally recognised qualification of a Certificate II in Sport and Recreation, focusing on either Soccer or Netball.

MUSIC ACADEMY

Ashdale Secondary College identifies, acknowledges and fosters its students' strengths. To embrace this philosophy, the College offers a Music Academy that embraces students' passion and commitment to extend their skills in Music.

Students in the Music Academy have the desire and commitment to improve in all aspects of their musicality, developing their music theory and performance and ensemble skills to excel within the music industry. They represent Ashdale Secondary College with pride and are positive ambassadors for the Academy and the College.

We aim to provide an avenue for your child to achieve excellence in all areas of Music, including written, composition and performance, with a focus on their chosen instrument or voice. Students within the Academy will have two class music sessions each week, a weekly instrument/voice lesson through Instrumental Music School Services (IMSS) or their private tutor. They will participate in at least one school ensemble suitable for their instrument/voice.



The focus of the Music Academy is not only on performance skills but the development of social and interpersonal skills, leadership skills, and the sense of belonging to the Ashdale Community. Students will have numerous performance opportunities throughout the program, including school services and assemblies, lunchtime concerts, mid-year and end of year concerts, community performances and external competitions, and adjudicated festivals.

If students continue into Senior School, they will complete the nationally recognised qualification of a Certificate II in Music (Year 11 and 12, two years) with a combined focus on Live Performance and Sound Production
