Ashdale Secondary College identifies, acknowledges and fosters its students' strengths. To embrace this philosophy, the College offers a Soccer Academy to male and female students, which encourages students' passion, commitment and skill in Physical Education.

Students in the Academy have the desire and commitment to improve their skills, game play and fitness to excel within the sporting arena. They proudly represent Ashdale Secondary College and are positive ambassadors for the Academy and the College.

We aim to provide an avenue for your child to achieve excellence in their chosen sporting domain. Students within the Academy will focus on soccer for two sessions of Physical Education each week. Students can build on their passion for the sport by developing skills, fitness, strategies, tactics and officiating. Throughout the program, students will have exposure to coaching experts and guest speakers, opportunities to attain coaching and umpiring qualifications and work with younger athletes from the Cluster primary schools. Students interested may be required to complete a trial process to become part of the program.

The ASC Soccer Academy focuses on physical skills, developing social and interpersonal skills, and the sense of belonging to a team and the Ashdale Community. In Year 7, students participate in team-building beach games focusing on teamwork. As students progress into Year 9, they are allowed to represent ASC as spectators at State and National games. **Our Soccer Academy has won three State Soccer Championships in the past four years.**

Students in the Academy should aim to meet the following criteria at all times:

- Be a leader in the College and a positive role model to peers.
- Demonstrate outstanding attendance, behaviour and performance in all faculties across the College.
- Display a high level of organisation, punctuality and independence.
- Represent the College in SSWA Carnivals and Indoor Competitions.
- Wear appropriate uniform for Academy lessons, ie. PE sports uniform and soccer shoes.
- It is recommended students play soccer outside of school for a club.

In Year 10, students involved with the Academy will complete Sports Science Soccer, creating the foundations of a career pathway in the sport science industry.

Eligible Year 10 and 11 students will also have the opportunity to play in the Singa Cup in Singapore.

### Soccer Trial - Term 3:

Interested primary school students must be at Ashdale Secondary College at 8.30 am on the designated day.

The trial will take approximately one (1) and a half hours, after which they must be collected and returned to their primary school. Any students injured or unable to attend on the trial date will be viewed during Transition in Term 4.

Acceptance letters will be issued in Term 4.
